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Dear Praying Friends,

Greetings from our "Covered Wagon" and the Trail of Blessings! We have seen some great things this year! God has blessed with many miles (Coast to Coast) and many wonderful meetings. There have been people saved in services and on outreach as well as God's people who have made important decisions in their life. We thank God for the honor to serve him!

I apologize for not sending out a prayer letter earlier than this. We have been very busy and even though I had great intentions, I never did get it written. So, we are extremely thankful for your prayer support and friendship! We are also thankful for the opportunity to serve with some of God's greatest servants.

We have a **prayer request** that we ask you to lift before the throne of God. As many of you know we purchased a 2008 F350 dually last year that has been a tremendous blessing. We have been having some issues this summer with the loss of coolant and overheating (while climbing the mountain passes). I have consulted different mechanics, had the thermostats replaced, radiator flushed, etc. According to the last mechanic in Cheyenne, WY, I have done everything needed done to try and correct the problem. After a test drive with the computer attached and extensive amount of time looking things over, this is his thoughts. We either have a pin hole in our Head Gasket or the head has a very fine line crack in it. (I had a test done in Coeur d'Alene, ID that was negative on the loss of compression or head problems). However, it is still creating a problem. The mechanic in Cheyenne said to continue to watch the coolant level, take it easy down the road and there wouldn't be a problem nursing it home. So, I contacted my mechanic at home and this is what we are looking at: pulling into Amarillo late October where they will get on it and tear down and send the heads to the shop. If there is not any damage to the heads then they will be replacing the head gasket (and checking things out) in 3 days and \$4,500 so we can continue down the road to New Mexico, Utah, Idaho, Washington and back to New Mexico arriving back at home just before Thanksgiving. **If** the heads are damaged, we are looking at new heads and \$3,000 more totaling \$7,500 to \$8,000. **SO**, we are asking you to pray there is no damage to the heads and we only have to pray in \$4,500. I will keep you updated as we find out the news. Please feel free to contact me with any questions and I will do my best to answer them. Thank you again for praying.
